

CentOS 5 LDAP Authentication - Client

```
yum install -y openldap-clients nss_ldap
/sbin/chkconfig nscd on
```

```
authconfig --enableldap \
--enableldapauth \
--ldapserver=ldap.example.com \
--ldapbasedn="dc=example,dc=com" \
--enablemkhomedir \
--update
```

Thats it!

Enable Sudo Access to group ServerAdmins

```
sudo sh -c 'echo "# Members of the LDAP group ServerAdmins may run sudo" >> /etc/sudoers'
sudo sh -c 'echo "%ServerAdmins ALL=(root) ALL" >> /etc/sudoers'
```

Restrict to Group ServerAdmins

```
cat << 'EOL' >/etc/ldap.restrictions
root
wheel
ServerAdmins
EOL
```

```
nano /etc/pam.d/system-auth
```

Insert into top of File

```
auth required pam_listfile.so onerr=fail item=group sense=allow file=/etc/ldap.restrictions
```
